Paperwork Deadlines	2 weeks (In advance of effective date)	30 days (In advance of effective date)	 Renewal paperwork to Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Texas (BCBSTX) is due 30 days in advance of the effective date. December renewals are the exception: Paperwork is due 45 days in advance of the effective date. New business paperwork is due two weeks in advance of the effective date. Read more information on current renewals.
2016 Transitional Policy Extension	N/A	September, October, November and December 2016 Renewing Groups with existing transitional policy plans	Existing extended transition policies may be renewed for policy years beginning on or before Oct. 1, 2017, provided that all transition policies end by Dec. 31, 2017. This applies to groups enrolled in a benefit plan that existed before Jan. 1, 2014, and does not include all the Affordable Care Act requirements for qualified health plans.
NEW for 2016: Embedded Pediatric Dental	Pediatric Dental Attestation forms are no longer required.	Pediatric Dental Attestation forms are no longer required.	Beginning Jan. 1, 2016, pediatric dental services and rates for members up to age 19 will be embedded in all Affordable Care Act (ACA) metallic medical plans at no additional cost. This change means that Pediatric Dental Attestation forms are no longer required.
Composite Billing Option	Composite Rate Billing Method Declaration form is required.	Composite Rate Billing Method Declaration form is required.	Effective Dec. 1, 2015, premium rates for all ACA Metallic plans (including medical and dental plans) now include the option for accounts to view and be billed with a four-tier composite rate structure (Employee, Employee + Spouse, Employee + Child(ren) and Employee + Family (Spouse with children)). Existing groups with Composite Billing and renewing December 2016 do not need to resubmit the Composite Rate Billing Method Declaration form.
Revert from Composite Billing to Age Billing	N/A	Change Request (plus BPA if including plan changes)	If a renewing group currently has Composite Billing (ACA Metallic plans) and wants to revert back to Age Billing at renewal, the group must email the change request to sbscamend@bcbstx.com or fax to 972-231-6931. If making plan changes, also include the BPA.
MSP Information Submission	Included with the Employer Group Information form	September 16 Deadline Submit on BAE	Data collection efforts are underway for groups to update Medicare Secondary Payer (MSP) information through <u>Blue Access for EmployersSM (BAESM)</u> . Read <u>article</u> details.
In-Vitro Fertilization (IVF) Benefits	Double check BPA selection	Double check BPA selection	 The IVF purchase option is required for applying groups. Employers have the option of accepting or declining the IVF benefits. Caution: If IVF is selected, significant rating impacts will apply. Double check the Benefit Program Application (BPA). Request to remove the IVF benefit after selecting will require the group to make an Anniversary Date change.
